4. Is he able to complete his paper in time?

5. Is he able to reproduce correctly in examination?



Common factors:

Is his mind pre-occupied with something? Family problems, peer pressure etc. Is the student extrovert or introvert?

Some noise outside the examination hall, incident on the way to school or examination hall.
